RTLB assisted Mr. Gene Connor with much needed home repairs on April 27th. More than 25 volunteers from Rebuilding Together completed roof repairs and home structural improvements as part of Heroes at Home, a program created through the collaboration of Sears Holdings Corporation and Rebuilding Together to improve the lives of the military and their families through extensive home rehabilitation. Gene Connor requested RTLB's services back in March and upon evaluation by a team of skilled contractors, he was approved for several safety related concerns throughout the home. The value of the labor and donations he received totaled over \$1,200.00. As a longtime resident of Naples Islands and an active community advocate for over 25 years, Gene was honored and humbled to be a recipient of such a gift. "My house was falling
