Since 1992, we at RTLB have worked diligently to raise funds and mobilize volunteers so that we may provide the home repairs and modifications that low-income homeowners need in order to live safely, securely, independently, and with dignity. We provide these services at no cost to homeowners, who may be elderly or disabled or a family with children. We provide analogous services to nonprofit organizations whose missions are compatible with ours.

Over these last two decades, we have successfully leveraged the services of over 12,000 volunteers, who have worked in excess of 93,000 hours to complete projects on more than 225 homes and 45 nonprofit facilities in the Long Beach area. These

The need for our services in Long Beach is great, as the combination of poverty, age, and disability here is overwhelming: One in five residents is below the poverty level; one in five is above 65 years of age; about half of the residences are owner-occupied, and one in four of these is owned by someone over the age of 65; and two of five over the age of 65 are disabled.
