- Months of extensive planning and preparation lead up to our semi-annual rebuilding days held the last Saturdays of April and October.
- Rebuilding Together is based in principle on the concept of an old-fashioned barn raising with as many as 100 skilled and unskilled volunteers assigned to a particular project.
- Funding comes from corporate sponsors, individuals, local businesses, labor organizations, foundations, civic organizations and religious groups interested in helping to build a better community.
- The largest volunteer home rehabilitation organization in America with affiliates in 865 cities and towns in all 50 states.
- Founded in 1992, Rebuilding Together Long Beach now has rehabilitated more than 275 homes and nonprofit facilities throughout the Long Beach Area with the help of over 12,000 volunteers. The estimated market value of the local effort is well over \$4.5 million so far.
